Playgroup was incorporated as the Echo Park Silver People's Child Care Center, a non-profit community organization, in 1974.

Playgroup was a pioneer in the use of anti-bias curriculum and has been a vocal advocate for children and families throughout its history.

Educators use tools of documentation, such as note taking and video, to reveal children's thought process and to extend a line of inquiry/exploration.
